- Outlines and measurements are based on a CT-scan executed at the AST-RX platform MNHN Paris in July 2022 (voxel size: 127 µm)
 - The letters B and T indicate the bass and treble side of the instrument
 - The positions of cross sections are indicated with red arrows and red letters
 - The distance between the purfling and the edge is irregular, fluctuating from ca. 3,5 mm to 3,9 mm. The width of the black purflings is ca. 0,4 mm, the white purfling 0,5 mm.
 - The side views correspond with the centreline of the instrument
 - The walls of the f-holes are not parallel. The minimum distances orthogonal to the drawing plane are given.
 - The green coloured dotted lines and areas represent later changes and repair patches
 - All measurements in millimeter
